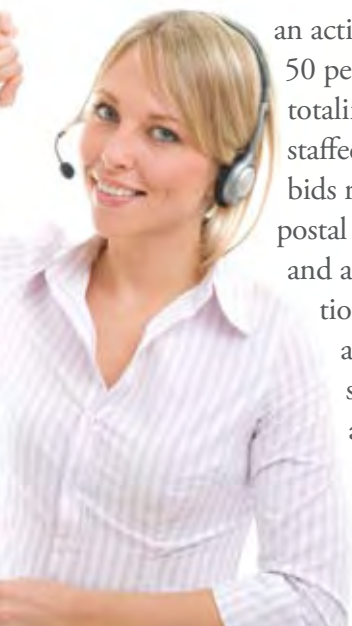

As a service to our customers we offer a customized recommended spares list for each new build of coaches. The bill of material for the new coach is compared to our existing inventory and adjusted accordingly to assure availability of the new components. ***In addition, we are always willing to work with the customer to analyze specific needs based on their unique operating conditions and adjust our stocking levels accordingly.*** North American Bus Industries has recently increased manpower in our purchasing and inventory control environments to accommodate customer requirements for critical need items. Normal shipping goals for stock items include a turn around of 48 hours from time of order receipt until shipment is made and same day shipment of critical need or coach down items.
